A) eChat Coop Service Oversight. Committee voted to:

- Analysis of chat activity using Python to identify useful trends to detect and plan for (Fullerton leading this project)
- Possible option to expand use of Springshare products in innovative ways. Perhaps a conference/symposium session.

B) ULMS Systems Support. Committee voted to:

- Create official ULMS /STIM liaison. Mike DeMars offered to be conduit between STIM and ULMS.
- Explore a structure for working on ULMS projects that are of systemwide value. Eric Beck will create language to consider.
