- 90% of UH system consortial purchases for research materials are paid for by UH Mānoa
- UH Mānoa Library provides 100% of the system-wide integrated catalog and shared resources support to UH System Libraries and external partners

- Partnerships within the local educational community
- Community-inspired public exhibits featuring our collections
- Faculty Lecture Series open to the public
- Preservation workshops to help the community preserve books, photographs, family archives
- Collaborative projects and events with campus and community organizations

- 6,795 students introduced to research methods and resources
- 522 classes taught by faculty librarians

RESEARCH

- \$6.8 million in Library funds spent on resources to support research
- UH raised \$330 million in grants (2009), supported by Library resources
- 24 Library subject liaisons work with academic departments
- Library hosted and maintained online Institutional repositories
- Increase International access to locally produced research

STUDY SPACE

- 244 computers available for student use in 2 library facilities (Hamilton and Sinclair)
- 1,400 study seats
- 13 collaborative work spaces
- 34 research rooms
- 3 fully-equipped practice presentation rooms
- Open 24 hour/5 days during semester and 24/7 access during finals
