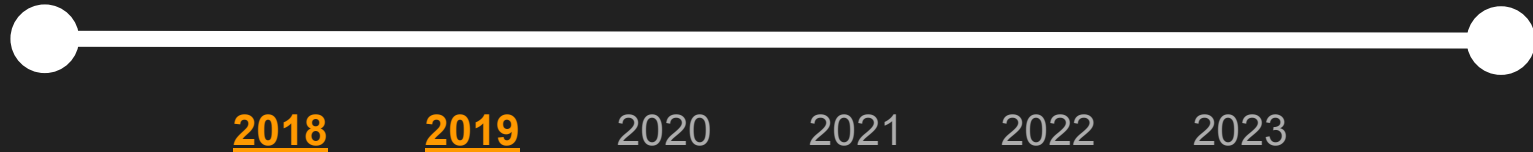

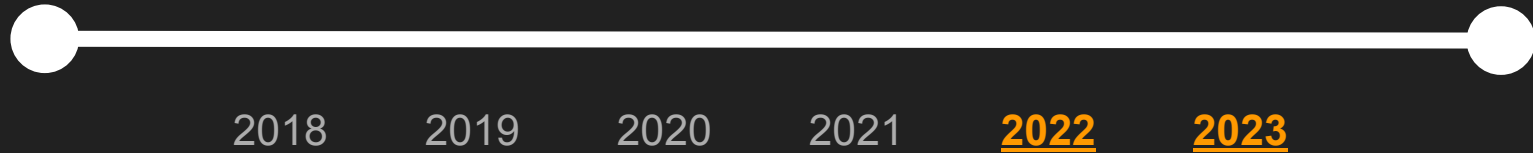

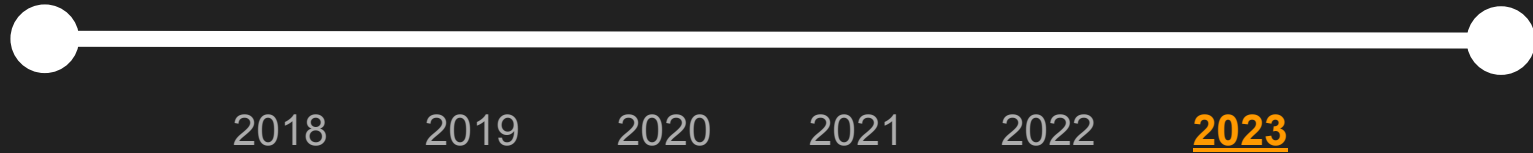
# How we got here: A DAWG review

# How we got here: A DAWG review



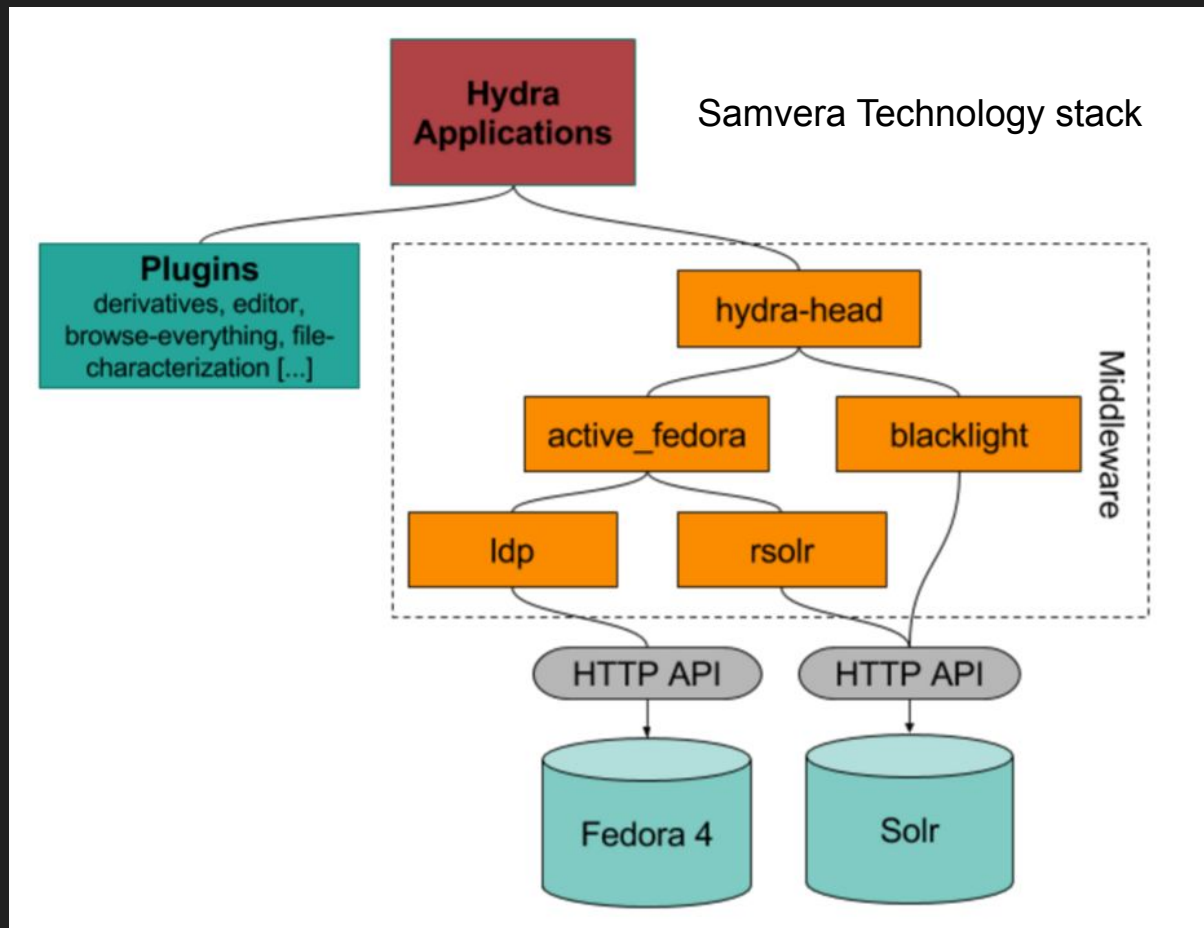
## Official CSU Digital Archives arrives
