A search on "flowers" brings up [a lot of results](#) if you want to look at our Primo.

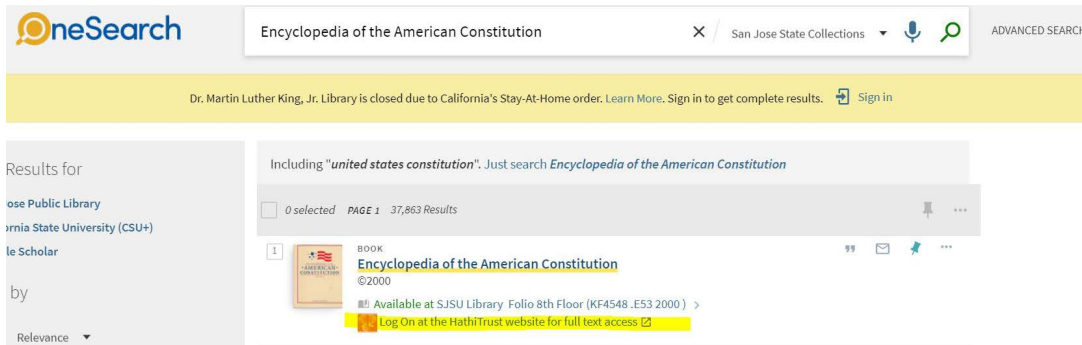
Some language we shared with users:

Due to the current COVID-19 shelter-in-place order, the Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Library is currently closed and its physical collections inaccessible. However, due to HathiTrust membership, SJSU Library has requested and been granted Emergency Temporary Access Service (ETAS), which allows online reading access to inaccessible physical holdings. Through HathiTrust, SJSU Library users will be able to access materials that are under copyright, as well as over 6.7 million public domain and Creative Commons-licensed works. This includes access to over half of the titles in the SJSU Library's print collection. Our level of access is in accordance with our collection holdings; one physical copy on the shelf is equal to one available digital copy. This conforms to fair use under US copyright law. Digital access to these materials will be provided throughout the involuntary disruption to our physical services.

I provided examples to our library because we also have the *HathiTrust Digital Library Full View U.S. Only* collection activated in Alma, plus we have 32,000+ other records that we had set up years ago separate from this membership.

This record is an example of the ETA granted.
