

In Worldshare Collection Manager, OCLC outputs Marc files for various collections in the same ftp folder.
(Ex: metacoll/out/ongoing/updates)

For example, the Chancellor's Office has collections for the Daily OCLC load and the Jstor DDA program.

If you have 2 or more Alma import profiles that are fetching files from the same ftp folder, you can use regular expressions to distinguish the various Marc files.

You can use regular expressions to specify which Marc file(s) the import profile should load.

```
* (?=*?\bJstorDdaDiscovery\b) *mrc$
```

The text in between the `\b` should be the file name you specified in WCM.

`*mrc$` indicates that you only want to import files ending in mrc.

In Alma, you can test the ftp connection and preview which files will be downloaded.
