# Goal

To configure and implement the Alma LSP to achieve the UW Systems' stated objective - "One System, One Library."

# Statement of Need

On behalf of the Council of Wisconsin Libraries, UW System Administration has signed a contract with Ex Libris and acquired the Alma library system - a robust LSP that will provide high quality and cost-effective services to its users.

Issues driving the purchase:

- 1. Disparate functional and operational systems hamper service delivery
- 2. Separate public catalogs complicate discovery and sharing of resources
- 3. Significant duplication of work across the system reduces staff efficiency
- Non-integrated UWS enterprise systems hamper efficiency of library management and business practices
- 5. Lack of single platform complicates the making of decisions based on what's best for all libraries in the consortium.

# **Expected Benefits**

- 1. Complete functional and operational integration will improve service delivery
- Access to a unified UWS public catalog interface will simplify discovery and sharing
- 3. Less duplication of work will increase staff efficiency
- 4. Integration with key UWS enterprise systems will improve business practices
- A single consortium platform through which back office functions are conducted will facilitate consortium decision making

# **Potential Risks**

- 1. Reallocation of UW project resources to other priorities may cause delays
- 2. Slippage of the vendor schedule
