Holdings Records for Accession/Shelving Control numbers

Background

When holdings records with accession numbers were created in Alma during migration, many were created with 852 8_fields and the accession numbers stored in the 852 \$\$h. Our <u>best practices</u> recommend, and the <u>MARC21 holdings</u> <u>standard</u> stipulate, using first indicator 4 (shelving control) and storing the accession number is 852\$\$j.

Step-by-step guide

Configure Physical Location

- 1. Go to Alma Configuration > Fulfillment.
- 2. Select your library from the **Configuring** drop-down menu.
- 3. Go to Locations > Physical Locations.
- 4. Find and click on the location code.
- 5. In the Edit Physical Location page, go to the Holdings Configurations section.
- 6. Set Accession Placement to Shelving Location (852 \$\$j).
- 7. Set Call Number Type to Shelving control number.
- 8. Click on Save.

Normalize Existing Holdings Records

- 1. Create a set of physical items (suggested criteria: permanent physical location and permanent call number contains accession number prefix).
- 2. Create a normalization rule.
- Suggested rule*:

```
rule "Change 852 for accession number"

when
    (TRUE)

then
    changeFirstIndicator "852" to "4"
    changeSubField "852.h" to "j"

end
```

*optionally edit or add field-level conditions for accession number strings accordingly

- 4. Go to Alma Configuration > Resources > Cataloging > Metadata Configuration and select the MARC21 Holding profile.
- 5. Configure a normalization process based on the norm rule.
- 6. Run a change holdings information job on the set of physical items, selecting the normalization process from the "Correct the data using normalization rules" drop-down menu in the **Enter Task Parameters** page.
