Import Profiles Using the NZ

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Background

Campuses have the ability to create and configure new order and repository import profiles that use the NZ. Records brought into Alma via these import profiles can find a match in the NZ. Upon matching, these records can either merge with, or overlay, NZ records. It is important to use the most precise match method to prevent merging with or overlaying the wrong record.

Policy Statement

When a campus configures an import profile that uses the NZ and a merge method, the match method must be **Unique OCLC Identifier**. The merge method must be **CSU Bib Overlay NZ**.

This method matches precisely on the OCLC number in the 035 field and prevents potential overlaying the wrong record and/or wrong format (e.g., ebook record overlaying print book record). The merge method will ensure that the most recent WorldCat metadata is included in the Alma NZ record.


If a campus configures an import profile that uses the NZ and does *not* use the **Unique OCLC Identifier** match method, e.g. to bring in brief order bibs with no OCLC number, the Upon match action must be **Use NZ record.** This will ensure that the existing NZ record will not be inadvertently overlaid in error.


Check the Profile Details tab to determine whether an import profile uses the NZ.
